

TRANSITION YEAR COACHING COURSE 2016/2017

The Kilmacud Crokes GAA Club Coaching Department are organising a Coaching Course for students in the Transition Year Programme. The course will be suited to students who have an interest in Sport or might be interested in a career in Sport or in Teaching.

Students will have to complete a 1.5 hour Introductory module outside of school hours in Kilmacud Crokes. Included in the module is a theoretical session dealing with the priorities and the principles of coaching children. Students will also have to be available to coach on the following 2 Saturday mornings at the Club Nurseries in order to get the practical element of the course completed.

To qualify to work on our camps the students must be members of <u>Kilmacud Crokes</u> <u>GAA Club.</u> Students must also complete the following:

- The Transition Year Coaching Course or a Foundation Award Course
- Help out with the running of some Primary School Blitzes and/or the Club Nurseries and the running of the Mini All Irelands in June

- Saturday 1th Oct & 8th Oct (times to be confirmed but it will be between 9am & 12noon)

Students who complete this course will also have an opportunity to gain experience coaching during School time in some of the local primary Schools.
