

## **KILMACUD CROKES GAA CLUB Summer Camps 2015**



Hurling & Camogie: Monday 17th August - Friday 21st August Gaelic Football: Monday 24th August - Friday 28th August

The Kilmacud Crokes GAA Summer Camps incorporate a wide range of Gaelic Football, Hurling & Camogie activities, providing children with learning experiences in an environment of Fun & Enjoyment. The Camps are open to boys & girls aged 5 - 14 and are suitable for all, from beginners to children who have been playing the game for many years.

Players are divided into various groups according to age & ability. The emphasis of the camp is on the acquisition and improvement of individual skills in a game based programme. Each child will receive a Kilmacud Crokes Camp gift.

The camps begin at 10am each morning and finish at 2.30pm each afternoon.

€110 for 1 child doing 2 weeks (Child will receive 1 camp gift) Family package (2 or more children) €55 per child per week

## WHAT TO BRING

- Suitable playing gear: Tracksuit, Shorts and Football Boots.
- A change of gear or wet gear in case of rain.
- Hurley and Hurling Helmet (Hurley's and Helmets can be purchased in the Kilmacud Crokes Club Shop which is open in the Club-house on Saturday mornings 10.30am to 1.00pm and Thursday Evenings 8.30pm to 10.30pm.) Alternatively Helmets & Hurleys can be rented for the week of the camp at a cost of €5.
- A packed lunch including a drink.
