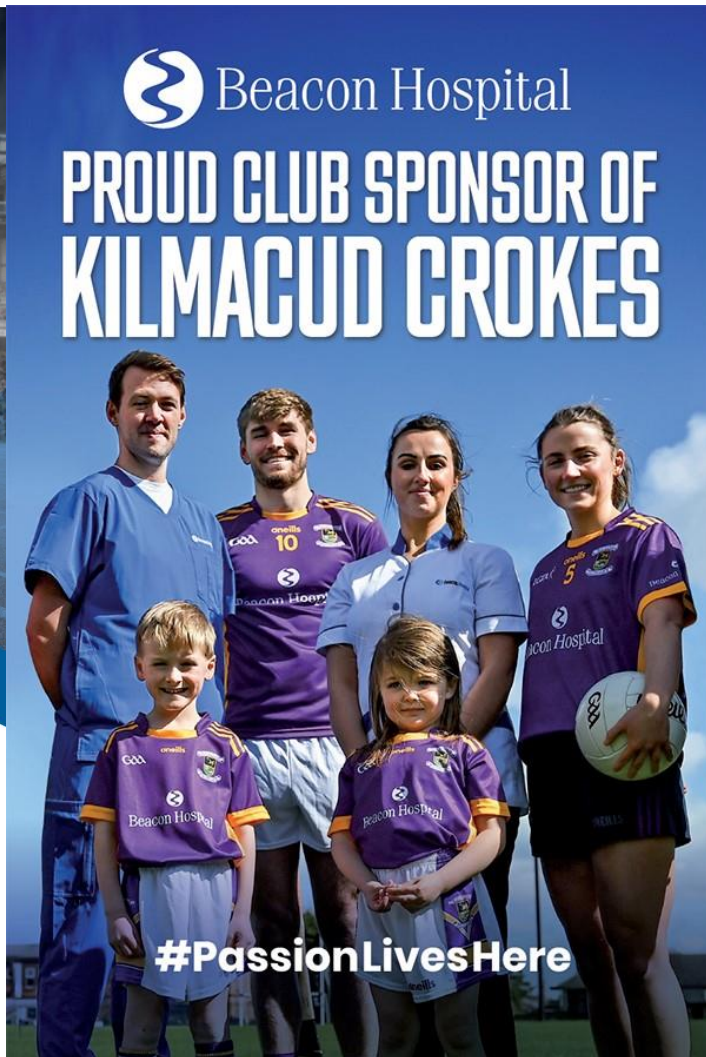

14:10-14:55	Finales	'Finale' matches will be played across six pitches.
15:15	Presentation & close	Presentation at Registration Area.

Blitz spirit & code

Kilmacud Crokes subscribes to and promotes the GAA code of conduct and expects this of all visiting teams. Players along with team managers, parents and supporters are expected to demonstrate respect for the game, each other, opponents, referees, festival officials and venue. Offending players will be subject to the unquestioned decision of the referee. Identified repeat offenders off the pitch will be asked to leave, to ensure the enjoyment of the majority is not compromised.

Event information

Tournament format

- 24 teams from 9 clubs will play across 6 pitches as per attached venue map.
- Teams are requested to wear their club colours.
- Each team will play 3 round-robin matches within their group. The festival will conclude with each team playing a fourth 'finale' game. This is a festival, not a tournament, everybody is a winner.
- In deciding how the 'finales' will be played, each team will be paired with another team of equivalent abilities form a different group for the final match. There will be 12 'finales'.
- **Teams can expect to play on a different pitch for their finale game. This will be communicated via the festival WhatsApp group.**
- At the conclusion of the finales, teams are kindly requested to immediately return to the Registration Area for a presentation prior to departing the festival.

Match rules

- **Team size:** 9 a-side with rolling substitutions. The format will be 1-3-2-3.
- **Match duration:** all games will be 20-minutes duration, with **immediate** turnaround at half time (no half-time team-talk). Start and full time will be sounded via air-horn.
- **Break between matches:** 5-minute turnaround between games – late teams will forfeit game.
- **Scoring:** 3 points for a goal; 1 point for a 'point'.
- **Puckouts:** Puckout to be taken by goalkeeper after scores and wides. Goalkeeper may advance 5m. Opposition must be 10m away from goalkeeper.
- **Solo running:** Players are permitted to run 4 steps, then solo for 4 steps and then run another 4 steps.
- **'65s':** No 65s, except where sliotar is struck out deliberately by defending team. Any 65s awarded will be taken from half-way line.
- **Frees & 65s** to be taken as per adult hurling.
- **Frees & sidelines** to be taken by the fouled or nearest player. Opposition must be 10m away.
- **Positive encouragement** of players from the side-line is always expected. Referees have been instructed to conclude games if under duress from the side-line.
- **The referee's decision in all matters is final.**
- Matches will be started and finished by a centrally timed air-horn – one blow to start a game and two to end a game. Teams not ready to start will forfeit their match and a 'win' awarded to their opponents. Timings will be strictly enforced as we have 48 games on the day.

Event information

Cancellation

- In the event of adverse weather conditions, Kilmacud Crokes Festival Co-ordinators will make a decision by 3pm Saturday 7th October, notifying teams in the event of festival cancellation in the interests of health and safety of the boys.

Safety

- Please take note of the pedestrian crossings. Adults & children should cross only at this point. **It is essential that each club ensures that its players are accompanied whenever they cross this road, as it is the main road through UCD.**
- First aid station is located at the Registration Area.
- All children on pitch must wear helmets at all times.

Parking

- Coach and car parking is available as per map.
- Please note cars should not be parked along roadside by pitches – this creates a crossing hazard for children, and the venue has an active clamping system in operation.

Logistics

- **Check-in:** each visiting club should check-in at Registration Area at 10.45.
- **Participation fee:** please remember to pay the registration fee in advance by Revolut: €50 per team (max €100 per club).
- **Warm-up:** after registration, teams may warm-up, but should be at the Registration Area for the parade by 11:10. There will be no time for further warm-up after the parade.
- **Catering for players:** there will be crate of refreshments available for each team, which will include sandwiches and snacks. Team mentors can collect this from the sports hall opposite the venue – see map and ‘Lunch for Teams’.
- **Toilets** are located in Sports Hall.
- **Complimentary tea & coffee** is available for adults at the Registration Area.
- **Keep it tidy!** Teams are requested to clean up after themselves and use the bins provided – this is being run as an environmentally friendly event.
- **Timing:** matches will be started and finished by a centrally timed air-horn – one blow to start a game and two to end a game.

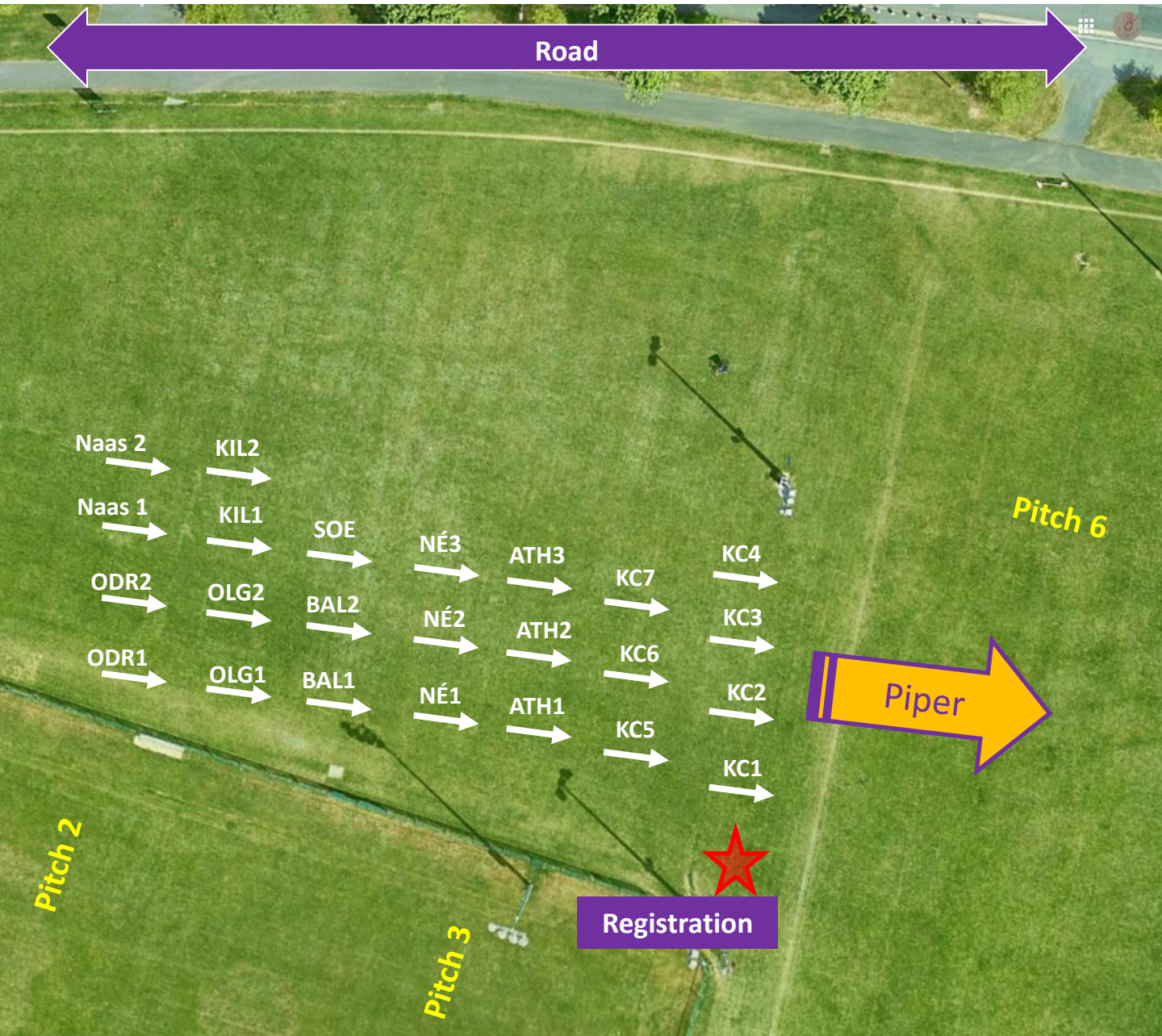

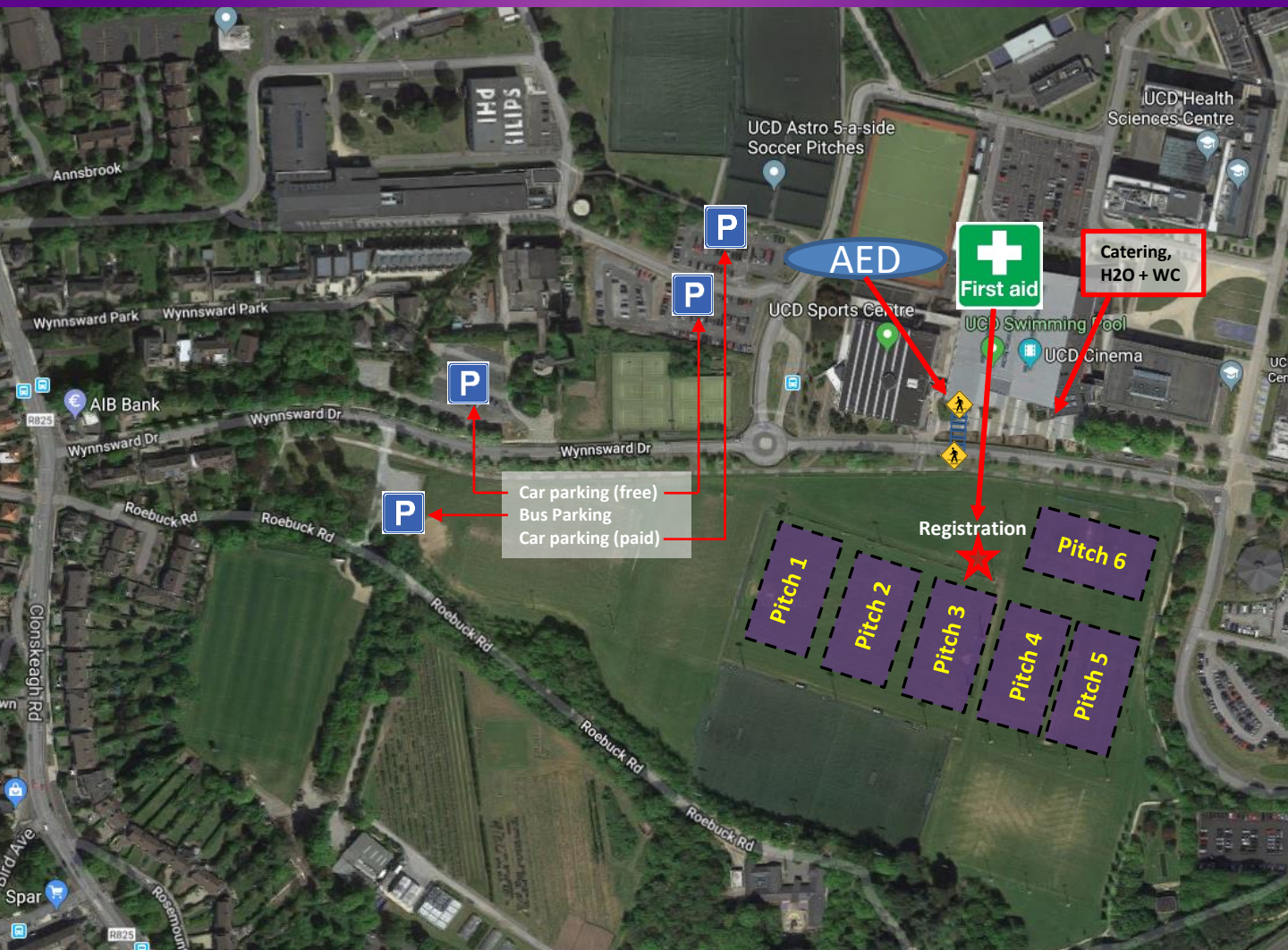
Directions
