

## OVER 2,000 GIRLS & BOYS TO TAKE PART IN 2024 KILMACUD CROKES MINI-ALL IRELAND BLITZ COMPETITIONS

Dublin, Monday, 20 May 2024: Kilmacud Crokes GAA Club is delighted to announce the return of its annual Mini All-Irelands Blitz competitions. Every week for four weeks, from May 27th, the South Dublin club will hold a blitz competition for boys and girls aged between 5 and 12, in each of the four Gaelic Games codes of camogie, football, ladies football and hurling.

Taking place in our home pitch of Páirc de Búrca, the competitions will see more than 2,000 children play midweek matches culminating in a finale evening every Friday, supporting the club's ambition of promoting Gaelic Games in Dublin.

The blitz competitions also serve to showcase the many ways in which clubs like Kilmacud Crokes can help sustain a lifetime of involvement in Gaelic Games, reaping the benefits both on and off the field of play. Each manager, coach, and referee roles are fulfilled by young people from within Kilmacud Crokes, with support coming from dozens of adult volunteers.

A much-loved feature of the Mini All-Ireland Blitz Competitions are the jerseys worn by the young players. This year Kilmacud Crokes have developed vibrant new Mini All-Ireland County jerseys, representing some of Ireland's best known county teams, that will be worn by all the players and managers. The Mini-All Ireland Blitz Competitions are facilitated by the continued support from club sponsors, the Beacon Hospital, as well as Spirit Motor Group, the Clayton Hotel Leopardstown and PTSB.









Speaking at the launch of the Mini All-Irelands, club chairperson, Joan Kehoe commented:
